It is essential that you pre-order your requirement as we do not carry a general stock of products.

We receive 3 shipments of products from early January through to mid February, if you require your order for a specific date please advise us in order that we can ensure that they are booked on the correct shipment.

A guide to stock arrival dates are detailed below

Load 1 - stock expected to arrive week commencing 7th January 2019

Load 2 - stock expected to arrive week commencing 21st January 2019

Load 3 - stock expected to arrive week commencing 11th February 2019

All seed potatoes are sold subject to availability at time of ordering, safe harvest, classification and crop out turn. Prices are subject to change without any prior notice. All seed is sold subject to being unsold or available at the time of order. All seed potatoes purchased from JBA are offered on a maximum grading size variation of 25mm, with the smallest size being 25mm and the larger size being 60mm. Health status wise, all stock will be a minimum of grade A, which are intended for personal/retail use only and are not to be grown as Basic or Certified Seed unless you have written permission from JBA. We will make reasonable arrangements for protecting the seed potatoes from frost damage during storage, at the loading point and during transportation. We cannot be held responsible for frost damage once delivery has been made. All varieties are sold subject to these conditions and by agreeing to purchase you are agreeing to these terms. All sales subject to BPTA terms and conditions.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT SEED POTATOES ARE PROTECTED FROM FROST - WE ADVISE THAT ALL SEED IS INSPECTED AT TIME OF DELIVERY

Onion Sets & Shallots are grown from seed and lifted as young immature products for re-planting outdoors from early spring. These products consist of inert matter which is the skin density, flesh and moisture content. Unfortunately the nature of the product is to absorb moisture in damp or moist environments. Therefore it is essential to provide the best possible conditions to get the most out of your sets.

Onion sets & shallots must be removed from the transportation nets and stored in thin layers in trays. They must be stored in light, airy, well ventilated rooms at temperatures between 5 - 8 degrees.

Onion Sets & Shallots react badly to being stored in the transportation bags when in variable or cold temperatures, with product often sweating in the bags causing dampness on the outer skin and even rooting, shooting and mould to form, resulting in significant losses due to rot over a period of time.

Every effort is taken to ensure our products are of the highest standards and quality both while in store and at the time of despatch, however we cannot accept responsibility for incorrectly stored product once delivery has been effected. Onion sets will perform in most conditions but are prone to stress in extreme conditions such as intense frosts and extended variable conditions, often resulting in the sets believing that the life cycle has been completed and therefore forming seed heads to produce the next generation crop. It is known that certain soft nose French types of Garlic will not withstand any extreme British winter, the hard nose varieties are less likely to rot in these circumstances.
